Treasures Report – 11/19 \$17,995.23 at Farmer Savings

Details, Roller skating \$382.24/49 skaters (106.50)

Family Fun Night – Spoke about Roller Skating going well. Had 49 participants. Noted flyer states what Pirate Parents contributed, but not what family expectation was. Next time state “free” or expected fee. Maybe revisit again in the spring.

Playground Update – Offering to get playground balls, also mesh bags/hooks for organization

Surveyed students to gather information on what is wanted, 4th and 5th grade soccer, basketball, football, high quality kick balls requested.

Spoke about the need for color coding or marking balls/grade

Mendy checking Dicks for color options

Covered when balls disappear, lost on roof, taken back to classroom, unattended children have access to them during non-school hours

Offer reward for responsibility for keeping balls

Coach Nye has a vendor for color coded balls

Mulch – Discussed the need for mulch. Some teachers are stating lots of mud, Mr. Clark says it’s bad timing. Mrs. B states it’s a mud pit many children are required to have boots or stay on blacktop. Spoke about rubber vs wood chips, pirate parents to look at playground during Santa shop this week and revisit.

GaGa Pit- Needs to be placed on mulch or blacktop area according to Mr. Clark. Mr. Griffin is working to see if concrete is needed for posts. Locations discussed, including moving/repairing toadstool climbing structures.

Santa Shoppe – Flyers coming home soon, Flyer gives an option of credit card pay, discussed removing that option.

Agreed, no credit card option, cash and check only at Santa Shoppe, returned checks are handled by Farmers bank, sent through multiple times and ultimately handled within pirate parents per Mendy.

Discussion on items still needed for Santa Shoppe, location 214 register in elementary office, baskets needed from storage, volunteer recruitment and sign-up process

Mendy purchased tote and Pirate Parent table supplies. Supplies on the PP table are meant for children who arrive at the Santa Shoppe with multiple people to buy for and low funds to do so.
